2. Explain the rules that must be adhered to when writing the introductory paragraph to any story. Use examples to support your explanation. [20 marks]
3. Describe **four** stages in editing a picture for use in a newspaper. [20 marks]
4. Describe **five** sources of news that a newspaper will use to identify stories. Use examples to support your description. [20 marks]
5. (a) Outline the **two** general types of law to which newspapers must adhere. [4 marks]
(b) Describe each of the following areas of the law of which a publication must be aware:
(i) Contempt of court [8 marks]
(ii) Privilege [8 marks]
6. Discuss the use of pictures in a newspaper. Use examples to support your discussion. [20 marks]
7. (a) Describe **five** types of text errors. Use examples to support your description. [15 marks]
(b) Outline the steps a sub-editor must take to check facts that are intended for publication. [5 marks]
8. Explain **four** typographical devices used by a sub-editor when designing a newspaper page. Use examples to support your explanation. [20 marks]
